## How to take Plenvu: (The day before your procedure)

1. At 6:00 am: Take four (4) tablets of Dulcolax (Bisacodyl)

and finish within 30 minutes.

- 2. At 12:00 pm (noon): Take another four (4) tablets of Dulcolax (Bisacodyl).
- 3A. At 6:00 pm: Use the mixing container to mix the contents of Dose 1 pouch with at least 16 ounces of water. Shake or use a spoon until completely dissolved. This may take up to 2 to 3 minutes. Finish the dose within 30 minutes.
  3B. After drinking the solution, refill the container with 16 ounces of clear liquid
- **4.** At 8:00 pm: With the remaining Dose 2 (Pouch A and B) mix and repeat steps 3A and 3B above.
- **5. Six (6) hours** before your procedure (\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_), take **one (1)** bottle of **Magnesium citrate.** This should be the last think you drink. You may **NOT** continue drinking liquids until after your procedure.

## If your prep is not satisfactory due to failure to follow the instructions

The doctor will have difficulty seeing the insides of your colon. You will have to redo the prep and come in for a repeat colonoscopy. You may also be subject to a \$100 fee.

- ❖ To prevent soreness from wiping, try soft toilet tissue or pre-moistened bathroom wipes.
- Drink plenty of water to keep yourself hydrated.
- If you experience anal irritation, try using Tucks or any brand of baby wipe followed by a generous application of Vaseline petroleum jelly to the external anus after each watery bowel movement.
- Feelings of bloating and nausea are common. This is temporary and will subside. You may also call our office at (301) 838-4224.
